

Motorhome crime is here to stay

In the event of the motorhome being driven without the driver ID tag present, an unauthorised key for example, an alert will be sent to the control centre within seconds. Recent evidence suggests that is the speed in detecting a motorhome theft using a "Cloned" key, that is the most important aspect of protecting the customers vehicle.

Remove the key you want to duplicate from the machine and then insert the original key

*SHADOW^{VTS} is a Thatcham approved GPS tracking system that is installed in your motorhome. When the engine is started, even before the motorhome is even moved, SHADOW^{VTS} will look for a dedicated driver identification device - one of the two Van Bitz supply when the SHADOW^{VTS} is installed. Should this ID Tag **not** be present, SHADOW^{VTS} will immediately contact the National Control Centre.*

In the very unlikely event that the motorhome should be towed away or, in the case of a smaller motorhome, be dragged onto a low loader, the system will alert the National Control Centre that an unauthorised movement is taking place. **The National Control Centre is an independent monitoring centre approved by the National Security Inspectorate.**

In addition to the vital monitoring of your motorhome 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, you can access the information that your motorhome is sending to the National Control Centre via an easy to use App.



So just what is "Cloning?"

Key cloning is a method by which a thief can program a new key into a vehicle without the owner's knowledge. This can be achieved using a low cost programming device connected to the OB Diagnostic port. In some cases, thieves can connect to the vehicle electronics without even entering the vehicle. You may think that could never happen, but thieves are cunning; they will wait for the driver to leave their vehicle and press the remote control to lock the vehicle as usual, but they are jamming the signal making you think that the vehicle is locked: But it's not!

Driver ID is **mandatory** and the ID tag can now be attached to the key ring.

Starter immobiliser is no longer mandatory under Thatcham VTS.

VHF only systems are no longer accredited under Thatcham VTS.

With the older Category 5 systems, the driver had to remember to carry separate ID devices. Really inconvenient should you leave home without one as you would be contacted every time you start the engine and have to explain yourself.
